RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the Dumpster Day event scheduled on December 5th, 2020 as a City Council sponsored Special Event.
2. Approve expenditure of office budget to purchase gift cards to thank volunteers, up to \$25 per card.
3. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
4. Place the item on the December 8th, 2020 City Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Dumpster Day event, sponsored by Councilmember Lan Diep, was held on December 5th, 2020 in Alviso. This special event is aimed at stemming illegal dumping. Several volunteers participated in this event. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Diep will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1).
