SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO MASTER CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH SCHAAF & WHEELER CONSULTANT CIVIL ENGINEERS FOR ENGINEERING ANALYSIS, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING SERVICES FOR LARGE TRASH CAPTURE PROJECTS

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the First Amendment to the Master Consultant Agreement with Schaaf & Wheeler Consultant Civil Engineers (Consultant) for engineering analysis, design, construction management and environmental consulting services for Large Trash Capture (LTC) projects, extending the term of the agreement from December 31, 2021 to December 31, 2024, with no increase to the maximum compensation.

BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

On June 28, 2016, the City Council approved the 8162-2 Master Consultant Agreement (Agreement) with Schaaf & Wheeler Consultant Civil Engineers, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for professional consulting services for LTC Projects. The original term was through December 31, 2021. The scope of the Agreement included engineering analysis, design, construction management and environmental consulting services for LTC projects.

The current 5-year Municipal Regional Stormwater Discharge Permit (MRP) that became effective January 1, 2016 was administratively extended and the next Stormwater Permit is anticipated to be reissued in July 2022. Provision C.10 – Trash Load Reduction - of the re-issued MRP would require the City to reduce trash discharges from 2009 levels to receiving waters in accordance with the following schedule: a) 90 percent by June 30, 2023; and b) 100 percent by June 30, 2025. Provision C.10 would also include the gradual removal of certain trash offsets the City has been using as credits for counting toward the reduction goals. To ensure compliance with the MRP, the City continues to implement LTC projects in the next several years with consultant supports for the project design and construction management.

City Council approval of the First Amendment to the Master Consultant Agreement with the consultant will allow the City to proceed with professional engineering services that are necessary to complete 9703 Large Trash Capture Device Installation Phase VII project and future City-wide LTC devices installation.

Climate Smart San Jose: The recommendation in this memo has no effect on Climate Smart San José energy, water, or mobility goals.

Commission Recommendation/Input: No commission recommendation or input is associated with this action.
