A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE REPEALING RESOLUTION NOS. 71319, 71816, 72943, 75230, AND 73532 RELATED TO THE CITY'S CONTINGENCY POLICY, THE CITY'S PREQUALIFICATION POLICY, AND THE AUTHORITY OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO AWARD AND EXECUTE CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2002, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 71319, which sets forth the City's contingency policy; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2003, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 71816, which sets forth the City's prequalification policy; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72943, which Resolution was amended on December 5, 2006 by Resolution No. 73532 and on December 15, 2009 by Resolution No. 75230, and addresses the authority of the Director of Public Works to award and execute certain public works contracts for \$1,000,000 or less; and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2019, the City Council approved an ordinance amending the San Jose Municipal Code by adding a new Title 27 to streamline the procurement and contracting of public works projects, and enact recent voter-approved changes to the City Charter related to the modernization of the City's project delivery process; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to repeal Resolution Nos. 71319, 71816, 72943, 75230, and 73532, all of which address policies incorporated into the new Title 27;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. Resolution No. 71319 is repealed effective the same day as the ordinance amending the San Jose Municipal Code to add a new Title 27 is effective.
2. Resolution No. 71816 is repealed effective the same day as the ordinance amending the San Jose Municipal Code to add a new Title 27 is effective.
3. Resolution Nos. 72943, 75230, and 73532 are repealed effective the same day as the ordinance amending the San Jose Municipal Code to add a new Title 27 is effective.
