Purpose: Mayor Sam Liccardo to be designated as a City of San José representative for the upcoming *Educational Seminar in Israel for Pacific Northwest Progressive Leaders*. Participants will include political and community leaders who seek to gain in-depth understanding of modern Israel and the U.S.-Israel relationship. by exploring critical policy and security issues affecting both Israel and the United States through discussion, on-site visits, and seminars. Participants will learn about innovative Israeli approaches to international and domestic issues for a deeper understanding of Israeli politics, society and culture. Pursuant to Council Policy 9-5, Travel by Elected and Appointed City Officials, this travel falls under an allowable use of the Mayor/Council Travel Budget under F.4.h, Travel is related to the Mayor's roles or duties.
