A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN JOSE TO: (A) ACCEPT AND EXPEND CYCLE 7 AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES GRANT FUNDING AWARDED TO RESOURCES FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO IMPLEMENT TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS AS DESCRIBED IN THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES GRANT APPLICATION; AND (B) AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT FUND AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS WITH RESOURCES FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT UP TO \$9,000,000 IN CYCLE 7 AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2024, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill No. 166 into law, establishing the sixth round of one-time Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention Program funds (“HHAP”), administered by the State of California’s Department of Housing and Community Development (“HCD”); and

WHEREAS, the HHAP Round 7 (“HHAP7”) funding was designed to provide jurisdictions with one-time grant funds to support regional coordination and expand or develop local capacity to address immediate homelessness challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to utilize HHAP7 grant funds to implement transportation improvements as described in the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities Grant application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to:

- A. Accept and expend Cycle 7 Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities grant funding awarded to Resources for Community Development to implement transportation improvements as described in the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities grant application.
- B. Negotiate and execute a Transportation Development Fund Agreement and related documents and agreements with Resources for Community Development up to \$9,000,000 in Cycle 7 Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities grant funding.
