

Challenges Arena Green


UCSV Board determined:

- Impacted by flight path


Opportunities Plaza de Cesar Chavez

UCSV Board determined:

- Site preferred to meet DEI goals (Diversity, Equity and Inclusion)
- Center of San Jose, preferrable for a 21st
 Century Park
- Highly-ranked site from Site Assessment Study

- Business associations


