### RECOMMENDATION

Approve a request to agendize for City Council deliberation on May 11, 2021, a \$2,500 SAP grant from Council District 10 to support the efforts of the Almaden Valley Women's Club to provide recreational and cultural opportunities to the community.

### **BACKGROUND**

Pursuant to City Council Expenditure and Reimbursement Policy, Policy Number 0-38, Section K "Grants", Item 6, "Any contribution to an organization proposed by a Council member who is a member of that organization must be approved in advance by the City Council."

Approval is requested to expend \$2,500 from the budgeted District 10 SAP Grant allocation to support the Almaden Valley Women's Club (AVWC). For the past 41 years, AVWC has been organizing the Almaden Art & Wine Festival, and the District 10 office has a long history of supporting their efforts. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, instead of the Art & Wine festival, they are hosting a Virtual 5K Run in an effort to continue to bring community together in a recreational fashion.

My wife, Silvia Mahan, is a member of AVWC. Because of my relationship with this organization it is appropriate for the full Council to approve this grant.
