

**SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF THE MEXICAN FLAG RAISING
SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 2,3,5,7 & 8 AS A CITY COUNCIL
SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT
DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the Mexican Flag raising held on September 13, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the October 2, 2019 Rules Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Mexican Flag raising was held on Friday September 13, 2019 at San José City Hall Plaza and is sponsored by Councilmembers Carrasco, Peralez, Jimenez, Esparza, and Arenas. This special event is to celebrate the rich Mexican Culture that has greatly impacted the City of San José. The event is free and open to the public.
