**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING
SECTION 12.08.110 OF CHAPTER 12.08 OF TITLE 12
INCREASING THE CITY'S ANNUAL GIFT LIMIT AMOUNT
FROM \$50 TO \$200, WHILE MAINTAINING THE \$50
ANNUAL GIFT LIMIT AMOUNT FROM LOBBYISTS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

Section 12.08.110 of Part 2, Chapter 12.08 of Title 12 of the San José Municipal Code
is amended to read as follows:

12.08.110 Gifts not prohibited.

This Chapter does not prohibit the acceptance or receipt of:

- A. Any gift that meets one of the exceptions under the Political Reform Act.
- B. Any gift, including meals and beverages, provided to an officer or employee in a business or social setting that has a value of ~~fifty-two hundred~~ dollars or less, as long as the total value of all such gifts received from any one Restricted Source does not exceed ~~fifty-two hundred~~ dollars in any calendar year; provided that gifts from lobbyists as defined in Section 12.12.180 shall not exceed fifty dollars in any calendar year.
