City Council Priority #13

 "Explore and develop an ordinance which would allow for a legal use of 'safe parking' in public and privately-owned parking lots for people who live in their vehicles."





Key Program Elements

- Applies to all vehicles
- Allowed on sites with Assembly uses, at least 3,000 square feet, including:
 - > Places of worship
 - ➤ Gymnasiums
 - > Libraries
 - ➤ Community Centers



Key Program Elements

- A permitted incidental use without the requirement of a Development Permit
- Vehicles arrive after 7:00 p.m. and depart before 10:00 a.m.
- Restrooms, water, refuse disposal, trash/recycling receptacles provided to participants
- Housing Department Registration, including Management Plan



Recommendation

Planning Commission Hearing, January 30, 2019

Approval of staff recommendation with two changes:

- > Extend morning operation hours from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
- Remove restriction to allow eating, food preparation, and cooking outside of vehicles and in temporary tents and structures
