SUPPLEMENTAL

RECOMMENDATION

Approve staff recommendation as directed in original memo, but drop appointment of the District 7 Neighborhoods Commissioner to allow for extended recruitment to expand the representation in District 7.

BACKGROUND

On August 9, 2016, Council Policy 0-4 was approved which outlined how unanticipated vacancies in Neighborhoods Commissions are handled.

The Council Appointment and Advisory Commission met on November 14, and interviewed eligible applicants. Because District 7 received only one application from a resident of a neighborhood which is already represented on the Neighborhoods Commission, we are asking for a deferral of the District 7 appointment to allow for extended recruitment in order to expand the representation in District 7.

ANALYSIS

Dropping the appointment of District 7 commissioner will reduce the number of commissioners for District 7, but allow for the recruitment in neighborhoods not currently represented on the Neighborhoods Commission.
