A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO DO THE FOLLOWING: 1) AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 8702 - 2018 SAN JOSE PAVEMENT PROJECT, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. STPL 5005 (152) TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,500,000 AND APPROVE A CONTINGENCY OF UP TO FIVE PERCENT OF THE CONTRACT AMOUNT, NOT TO EXCEED \$325,000; AND 2) CONSIDER ANY TIMELY BID PROTEST(S), MAKE THE CITY'S FINAL DETERMINATION AS TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER THAT IS RESPONSIBLE, OR REJECT ALL BIDS AND RE-BID THE PROJECT NOT IN MEMO

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose ("City") annually schedules streets to be resurfaced to improve their structural integrity, ride quality, and appearance, and extend the useful life of the streets in order to defer more costly reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, the 8702 - 2018 San Jose Pavement Project, Federal Project No. STPL 5005 (152) ("Project") will resurface 7.65 miles of arterial streets on the City's Major Street Network; and

WHEREAS, during the annual July hiatus, the City Council will not be meeting, and the City desires to authorize the Director of Public Works to award a construction contract for the Project so that work on the Project can commence in July 2018, and be completed prior to wintertime;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to:

1. Award a construction contract for the 8702 - 2018 San Jose Pavement Project, Federal Project No. STPL 5005 (152) to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000 and to approve a contingency of up to five percent of the contract amount not to exceed \$325,000.
2. Consider any timely bid protest(s), make the City's final determination as to the lowest responsive bidder that is responsible, or reject all bids and re-bid the Project.
