A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL TO THE VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR SUPPLEMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES FOR THE BERRYESSA/NORTH SAN JOSE BART STATION AREA WITH COSTS FOR SERVICES TO BE CHARGED COMPETITIVELY, INCLUDING AT OR BELOW FULL COST RECOVERY

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2019, the Valley Transportation Authority (“VTA”) released a Request for Proposals for supplemental law enforcement services in three locations; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose (“City”) desires to submit a proposal for the San Jose Police Department to provide supplemental law enforcement services for the future Berryessa/North San Jose (“BART”) station area; and

WHEREAS, the VTA Request for Proposals to provide supplemental law enforcement services for the future BART station area would cover law enforcement services for the station exterior, parking lots, and surrounding VTA property, but would not include the platforms, station, or trains, which will be covered by BART police; and

WHEREAS, if the San Jose Police Department is selected, City staff will return to Council for approval to enter into an agreement for supplemental law enforcement services with the VTA, at which time full details regarding budget, cost, and staffing will be provided for Council consideration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager is authorized to submit a proposal to the Valley Transportation Authority for Supplemental Law Enforcement Services for the Berryessa/North San Jose BART station area with costs for services to be charged competitively, including at or below full cost recovery.
