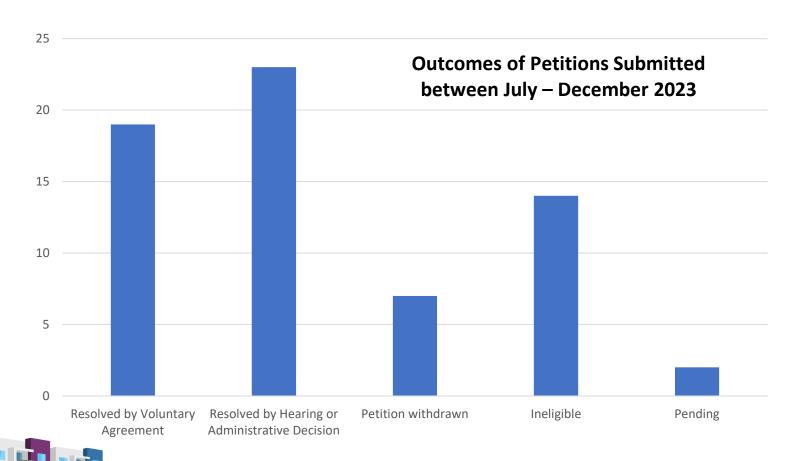

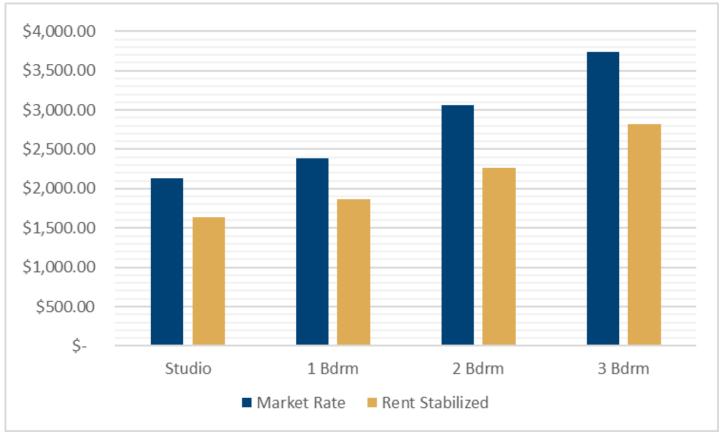


Petitions Submitted between July – Dec 2023

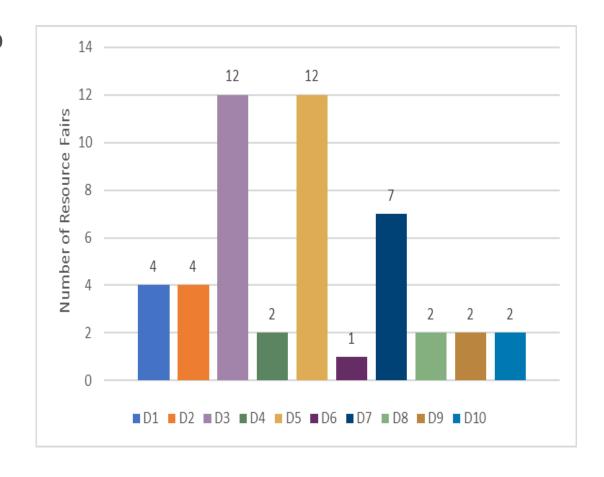
