NOTICE OF PARTICIPATION OF COMMISSIONER KIYOMI YAMAMOTO BY VIRTUAL ATTENDANCE IN THE COMMISSION MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 18, 2023.

Pursuant to AB2449, a member of the Commission must notify the legislative body at or prior to the meeting that they need to teleconference due to just cause (Childcare/caregiving, contagious illness, disability, official City travel). This is her first of two allowed just cause exemptions.

City staff will begin the meeting with opening remarks, introductions of staff and the consultant team, an overview of the meeting agenda, and the introduction of a new Commission member.

II. Staff Presentations

City staff and consultant team will review group agreements with the commission an seek adoption of the agreements. Staff will provide trainings to the commissioners, reviewing key requirements and regulations that apply to the Fund Commission related to the Brown Act, ethics, and governance of the commission. Staff will lead a conversation on commission bylaws and seek input from the commission on drafting and adopting bylaws. Staff will discuss the future meeting schedules. Following each staff presentation, Commission members will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide input.

III. Public Comment

Members of the public are invited to speak to the Commission about any discussion item that is on the agenda or on items that are not on the agenda but are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Commission.

Members of the public are usually given two (2) minutes to speak on any discussion item and/or during open forum; the time limit is in the discretion of the Chair of the meeting (City staff and its consultants) and may be limited when appropriate. Speakers using a translator will be given twice the time allotted to ensure non-English speakers receive the same opportunity to directly address the Fund Commission.

Please be advised that, by law, the Commission is unable to discuss or take action on issues presented during Public Comment. Pursuant to Government Code Section 54954.2, no matter shall be acted upon by the Commission unless listed on the agenda, which has been posted not less than 72 hours prior to meeting.
