Resolution Denouncing the Deportation of Vietnamese Immigrants. (Diep)

#### **Recommendation:**

- 1. Adopt a resolution denouncing President Donald Trump's attempted deportations of Vietnamese immigrants who arrived in the United States prior to 1995, unilaterally reinterpreting a longstanding agreement to the contrary;
- 2. Acknowledge the rights of refugees and asylum seekers to pursue sanctuary and avoid the endangerment that may accompany a forced return to their country of origin;
