- 2. Develop an ordinance that will limit any further overconcentration of tobacco businesses by:
- a. Limiting the sale of tobacco products near schools and other youth-sensitive areas or/and;
- b. Limiting the sale of tobacco products near existing businesses that sell tobacco product.
- 3. Remove the tobacco retail license exemption from the San Jose Municipal Code 6.87.210 that allows eighteen and over tobacco retailers to obtain a City license exemption.
- 4. Support stale and federal legislation to prohibit the sale of e-cigarettes and flavored tobacco products.
