The Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement requests a hearing to consider the adoption of a proposed abatement order to require the property owner by the end of ten (10) calendar days of the date of service of the Board's resolution to:

1. Remove and properly dispose of the dangerous accumulation of solid waste as defined in SJMC 9.10.280, including garbage, debris household items and all other miscellaneous items on the front yard.
2. Place a chain link fence across the front of the property to prevent future illegal dumping

Recommendation: Adopt the proposed abatement order requiring the property owner to take abatement action as set forth in the Staff Report dated July 10, 2019.
