1. <u>ROGC</u> 22-063

Nitrous Oxide Ordinance. (Davis)

Recommendation:

- 1. Direct the City Attorney to draft an ordinance banning the sale of nitrous oxide products in vape and smoke shops.
- a. Direct Staff to define "vape and smoke shops" and identify nitrous oxide products that will be banned at these retailers.
- b. Direct Staff to create a timeline for vape and smoke shops to cease nitrous oxide product sales.
- c. Work with SJPD and code enforcement to create a work plan to audit nitrous oxide product sales at vape and smoke shops.
- d. Direct Staff to explore fines and/or retail license suspension for vape and smoke shops that continue the sale of nitrous oxide after the ordinance goes into effect.
- 2. Require retailers who sell nitrous oxide products to display substance abuse resources.
- 3. Add this issue to our city's legislative priorities list to advocate for state legislation that prioritizes banning nitrous oxide product sales at vape and smoke shops.
