Recovery Objectives:


- Coordinate and facilitate the County's recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic

COVID-19 Recovery Report and Survey Consolidation

Gather existing community reports and survey results on COVID-19 recovery and create an analysis that will add to community input to be collected. Storytelling Project

Gather key quotes and photos of community members to paint a vivid picture of COVID-19 impacts. Engagement Toolkit

A toolkit for Committees to host their own activities/events

Lived Experience Group

10 trusted ambassadors on the ground gathering insights & carrying out activities/events. Information gathered will be shared w/Committees to inform recommended actions and final report


