Iterative Goal Development Process

RDA developed 4 goals based on listening session data and requests from MGPTF staff

MGPTF staff revised and added goals for a total of 8 goals 8 goals presented to the SWP Steering Committee for feedback

RDA and MGPTF met to review feedback RDA revised goals and sent to MGPTF for revisions MGPTF & RDA revised goals based on Interagency Team feedback

Draft Goal Options

Potential Goals for Inclusion in the 23-25 SWP

- 1. Continue to Strengthen the Continuum of Care (i.e., prevention, intervention, enforcement, reentry and overall)
- 2. Strengthen Community through Improvements in Community Spaces
- 3. Align Elements Focused on School Safety
- 4. Build Internal and Community Capacity to Support Overall Youth Wellness Efforts
- 5. Support Efforts Focused on Gun Safety

Goal: Continue to Strengthen the Continuum of Care (i.e., prevention, intervention, enforcement, reentry and overall)

- Expand Awareness of the Task Force through a targeted outreach approach (i.e., promotional materials, website, etc.) of available resources
- Lead or participate in a Regional/Statewide Violence Prevention Coalition to share best practices to inform the continuum of care
- Pursue collaborative funding opportunities (e.g., DA, probation, public health)
- Partner with recreation efforts (i.e., Pro-Com, Boys and Girls Club, etc.)
- Explore mobile recreation in Equity Priority Communities

Goal: Strengthen Community through Improvements in Community Spaces

- Explore/Assess built environments resources to address built environment (i.e., traffic calming, tree trimming, lighting, speed bumps, etc.)
- Create an Interdepartmental Strike Team/Coalition to assess and implement improvements in all Equity Priority Communities

Goal: Align Elements Focused on School Safety

- Refocus the City School Collaborative to include school safety
- Strengthen the Safe School Campus Initiative school safety strategy (e.g., restore/reaffirm School MDT's)
- Support more efficient coordination of BEST services on campuses
- Align with other school-based efforts (e.g., county initiatives)

Goal: Build Internal and Community Capacity to Support Overall Youth Wellness Efforts

- Facilitate training to taskforce and community providers in areas of youth wellness (i.e., homelessness, substance use, mental health)
- Improve connection/coordination with partners to meet the wellness needs of youth with a focus on crisis areas contributing to youth violence
- Align and strengthen partnerships with existing efforts in youth wellness areas

Goal: Support Efforts Focused on Gun Safety

- Support future gun safety policies or ordinances
- Continue to participate in Gun Safety Committee
- Support safe storage, buybacks, gun locks, etc.
- Explore best practices in other jurisdictions
- Monitor the Ghost gun epidemic
