SUBJECT: MASTER CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH WOODARD AND CURRAN, INC. TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING ANALYSIS, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING SERVICES FOR VARIOUS STORM AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the First Amendment to the Master Consultant Agreement with Woodard and Curran, Inc. (Consultant) for engineering analysis, design, construction management and environmental consulting services for various storm and sanitary sewer system improvement projects, extending the term of the agreement from January 31, 2022 to January 31, 2025, with no increase to the maximum compensation.

BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

On March 3, 2017, the City Council approved the 8165-2 Master Consultant Agreement with RMC Water and Environment, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for professional consulting services to provide Civil and Environmental Engineering services. The original term was through January 31, 2022. On April 9, 2018, the City consented to the assignment to Woodard and Curran of all right, title, interests and obligation of RMC Water and Environment under the Agreement, and the Consent to Assignment Agreement was executed by the City, RMC Water and Environment and Woodard and Curran, Inc. The scope of the Agreement included engineering analysis, design, construction management and environmental consulting services for various storm and sanitary sewer system improvement projects. An amount of \$439,513 from the original agreement remains unencumbered.

The Consultant has provided various consulting and engineering services for the City of San José storm drain system improvements, including the completion of the planning study and CEQA for the River Oaks Regional Stormwater Capture Project.

Council approval of the First Amendment to the Master Consultant Agreement will allow the Consultant to continue with professional engineering services for future storm infrastructure improvement projects.
