RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the Dumpster Day Events scheduled for May 7th 2022, May 21st, 2022 and June 4th, 2022 as City Council sponsored Special Events and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the events.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The May 7th, 2022 Dumpster Day at Patt Avenue, the May 21st, 2022 Dumpster Day at Rinehart Drive, and the June 4th, 2022 Dumpster Day at Woodridge Way will be sponsored by Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco. These special events will allow for residents to discard of items they no longer desire. The events will be free and open to the public and will follow appropriate local public health rules.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the events on her Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 5, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
