## **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1. Approve the D6 Better Together Faith Leaders Breakfast which will be held on May 26, 2022 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the May 10, 2022 Council Agenda for action.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

D6 Faith Leaders Breakfast is a non-denominational community event that will be held on May 26, 2022 at 2315 Canoas Garden Avenue at the Cathedral of Faith. This event is sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. This special non-denominational community event will host a celebration of community service to thank leaders from a spectrum of communities for their contributions, services and support to the residents of District 6. It will include a breakfast to thank organizations for their service to the City of San Jose prior to, during, and following the pandemic. This event is free and is open to the public.

### **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure

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requirements, Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 6, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
