1. Third Quarter Financial Reports for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

Public Comments: Blair Beekman offered comments.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Matt Mahan, seconded by Councilmember Sylvia Arenas, and carried unanimously, the Third Quarter (period ended March 31, 2022) Financial Reports for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 for the following programs:(a) Debt Management; (b) Investment Management; (c) Revenue Management; (d) Purchasing & Risk Management; were accepted and Third Quarter Financial Reports for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 were referred and cross-referenced the to the June 14, 2022 City Council Meeting for full adoption. 1. City of San José Disaster Resiliency Annual Report.

Director of the Office of Emergency Management, Ray Riordan and Nancy Ta, Resilience Coordinator City Manager's Office of Emergency Management provided the report.

2. Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE) Coordination Report.

Police Lieutenant, Ken Tran, Sexual Assault Unit Commander; Angelie Montesa, Crime & Intelligence Analyst provided a presentation. The presenters and Deputy Chief Elle Washburn responded to questions.

Councilmember Sylvia Arenas moved approval of the report, with the inclusion of a report out and update at a future meeting, and discussion about points of entry for survivors (calls for service) within our system.
