SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE PUERTO RICAN FLAG RAISING CEREMONY EVENT SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the Puerto Rican Flag Raising Ceremony event scheduled on Friday, July 29, 2022 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Puerto Rican Flag Raising will be held on Friday, July 29, 2022 in the City Hall Plaza and is sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez. This special event will bring together members of our community to celebrate the Puerto Rican culture and community that exists within our diverse city. It will also be an opportunity to learn about the rich Puerto Rican culture through the music and speakers that will be at the event. This event will be free and open to the public.

The display of the Puerto Rican Flag on Friday, July 29, 2022, is permitted under Council Policy 2- 1, Section C.3 - Flags Displayed in Conjunction With Official Ceremonial Items: "Other flags may be displayed in conjunction with official actions, ceremonial items, or proclamations of the City Council."

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
