On June 7, 2022, the City Council directed the City Clerk to count the ballots for the Renewal of the Downtown San José Property-Based Business Improvement District. The report out of the results of the election was deferred to June 14, 2022. This is a report of that tabulation.

The results of the tabulation are:

Property owners with a total of 1,287,485.92 votes have returned ballots in support of the levy of Assessments.

Property owners with a total of 164,729.15 votes have returned ballots in opposition of the levy of Assessments.

Ballots submitted by property owners in the Downtown San José Property-Based Business Improvement District in support of the levy of assessments exceed the ballots submitted in opposition to the levy of assessments. The City Council may proceed to vote on imposition of the assessment.
