Purpose:

The League of California Cities defends and expands local control through advocacy efforts in the Legislature, at the ballot box, in the courts, and through strategic outreach that informs and educates the public, policymakers, and opinion leaders. Cal Cities offers education and training programs designed to teach city officials about new developments in their field and exchange solutions to common challenges facing their cities.

The Board of Directors is responsible for the overall supervision, control, and direction of Cal Cities and consists of representatives from each of the Cal Cities 16 regional divisions, 10 municipal departments, five caucuses, and mayors of California's 10 largest cities, as well as 12 elected at-large members.
