

Consulting Services RFP: Master Agreements for Community Engagement and Facilitation Consultants

August 9, 2022

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| RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager or designee to:
 - a) Negotiate and execute up to nine master agreements for on-call community engagement consultants for terms through June 30, 2025, for a total maximum compensation of up to \$4 million.
 - b) Exercise options to extend the master agreements for up to an additional two years under the same terms and conditions.
 - c) Negotiate and execute amendments to the master agreements to shift funding between the master agreements provided the total maximum compensation does not exceed \$4 million.
2. Direct staff to conduct a separate procurement process for establishing a bench of on-call community-based organizations that can assist the City with engagement processes.

| RFP Process

- Developed an RFP for Consulting Services: Master Agreements for Community Engagement and Facilitation Consultants
- Submission period: April 12th through May 3rd
- Advertised through Biddingo, social media, and emails to approximately 130 community leaders
- Received 23 proposals
- A panel of three City staff evaluated the responses against the RFP criteria and recommended the award of contract (Master Agreements) to 9 consultants
- Received two protests from American Leadership Forum Silicon Valley and CatalyzeSV
