RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager or designee to:
- a) Negotiate and execute up to nine master agreements for on-call community engagement consultants for terms through June 30, 2025, for a total maximum compensation of up to \$4 million.
- b) Exercise options to extend the master agreements for up to an additional two years under the same terms and conditions.
- c) Negotiate and execute amendments to the master agreements to shift funding between the master agreements provided the total maximum compensation does not exceed \$4 million.
- 2. Direct staff to conduct a separate procurement process for establishing a bench of oncall community-based organizations that can assist the City with engagement processes.

- Advertised through Biddingo, social media, and emails to approximately 130 \bullet community leaders
- Received 23 proposals
- and recommended the award of contract (Master Agreements) to 9 consultants


