SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE MEXICAN FLAG RAISING EVENT COSPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 5 AND COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the Mexican Flag Raising event scheduled on September 15, 2022, as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the September 13, 2022, Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Mexican Flag Raising event will be hosted on September 15, 2022, at City Hall. This special event will provide an opportunity for community members to connect with Mexican American culture, access critical resources and enjoy an evening of entertainment, and activities. The event is free, open to the public, and sponsored by Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco, Councilmember Sergio Jimenez and the Komite de Fiestas Patrias en San Jose California.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 5, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
