FY 2021-22 Annual Priorities

- 🏠 Increase and Preserve Affordable Housing
- 🏠 Respond to Homelessness
- 🏠 Strengthen and Stabilize Communities
- 🏠 Promote Fair Housing Choices
- 🏠 *COVID-19 Response*



Increase and Preserve Affordable Housing Opportunities

- 🏠 **456** households received Rental Assistance and Case Management (38% female head of household)
- 🏠 **4** agencies administered rental assistance



Respond to Homelessness

- ▲ **1,404** individuals received street outreach engagement, case management and rapid response
- ▲ **304** individuals were served in overnight warming locations
- ▲ **189** families were assisted in the emergency motel program



Strengthen and Stabilize Communities – Public Services

- 🏠 **2,905** social visits with wellness checks were conducted to low-income seniors
- 🏠 **153** low-income individuals were provided legal consultations
- 🏠 **31** individuals received legal representation for eviction proceedings



Strengthen Neighborhoods – Public Services

- 🏠 **25,000** meals delivered to low-income seniors
- 🏠 **35** children provided childcare scholarships
- 🏠 **783** participants received leadership training


- 🏠 2nd Public Hearing City Council → September 20, 2022
