**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Appoint Councilmember Foley as Chair of the City's Vision Zero Task Force.
2. Appoint Councilmember Perez as Vice Chair of the City's Vision Zero Task Force.

**BACKGROUND:**

On February 11, 2020, the City Council formed the Vision Zero Task Force, and appointed Councilmember Perez as Chair.<sup>1</sup> Councilmember Foley was subsequently appointed as Vice Chair of the Task Force.

Councilmember Perez, in preparation of his departure from office, has requested that Councilmember Foley be elevated to Chair of the Vision Zero Task Force.

The Task Force, composed of cross agency and sector stakeholders, has convened for the past two years over eight meetings providing invaluable feedback on the City's Vision Zero program. However, considering the past two years continue to have high levels of traffic fatalities, it is critical that we have a seamless transition of leadership for this Task Force so that it can continue its work.
