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SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF MOVIE NIGHT AND JAZZ CONCERT EVENTS SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 AS CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENTS TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve Movie Nights and Jazz Concerts at Cahill Park, The Municipal Rose Garden, and Rosemary Gardens Park, that were scheduled on July 23, August 6, August 13, August 27, and October 1, 2022, as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Retroactively approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups that supported the events.
- 3. Place the item on the November 08, 2022, Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Movie Night events were held on July 23, August 13, and August 27, 2022, at W. San Fernando Street & Wilson Avenue, 1649 Naglee Ave, and 161 Sonora Ave. Jazz Concerts were held on August 6 and October 1, 2022, at 1649 Naglee Ave. The events were sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. These special events were an opportunity for residents to interact with each other and attend a park in District 6. The events were free and open to the public.

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ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 6, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.

The Office of the City Clerk will post the item on the City's Website for the November 2, 2022, Rules Committee Agenda and the November 8, 2022, City Council Agenda.
