Analysis

GREEN LIGHT: The Administration can implement this Nominated Idea under its current work plan. Item should be sent to Council to add to Department work plan. (1) How will the Idea be approached? (2) If adopted, what is its impact and/or tradeoff to the City Roadmap or to a Department work plan, including strategic support? (3) What is the minimum viable scope to move the Idea forward and reduce its complexity?
Citywide Planning Division staff are currently working on the Affordable Housing on Assembly Use Sites Policy (YIGBY), a policy framework to allow affordable housing to be constructed as a secondary use in conjunction with existing assembly uses. This item is on the FY 2022-2023 City Initiatives Roadmap. The scope of the "City-Initiated General Plan Amendment for Public/Quasi-Public Land Use Designation: Defining Permanent Supportive Housing" is more simplistic and requires less staff time than the scope of the YIGBY Policy. Therefore, by shifting from YIGBY to the new policy work, additional staff capacity would be created to work on other policy/ordinance items. In addition, the new policy work item, in conjunction with recent state laws that allow school districts to construct teacher housing on its land, would provide opportunities for redevelopment of school district land with residential uses. Therefore, the new policy work item eliminates the need for the Yes on School Land (YOSL) policy that is currently in the Citywide Planning's work program.
