#### **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Autumn Litter Harvest event was hosted on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, at different locations in District 5. This special event invited community members to earn service hours, meet neighbors, and help beautify San José streets. The Autumn Fun Fest event was hosted on October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at Mayfair Park. The special event invited community members to help unveil the new playground, present and honor the Keyla Salazar memorial mural, and partake in a movie night. The Cimarron Park Dumpster Day event was hosted on October 29th, 2022, at Cimarron Park. The special event allowed residents to discard unwanted items/garbage, thus keeping it off our city streets. The Warmsprings Dumpster Day event was hosted on November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, on Minidoka Avenue. The special event allowed residents to discard unwanted items/garbage, thus keeping it off our city streets. The Delano Manongs Park Ribbon Cutting event was hosted on November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at Delano Manongs Park. The special event paid homage to the contributions of our Filipino American community and invited residents to unveil the park and learn about their historic role in San José and beyond. The Pet Vaccination and Wellness event was held on November 13th, 2022, at Capitol Park. The special event allowed residents to vaccinate and check in on the health of their pets. The Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco Farewell Address was held on November 12th, 2022, at the Mexican Heritage Plaza. The special event allowed community members to learn about the accomplishments of Councilmember Carrasco's tenure and learn about how to stay civically engaged and connected. The Arbuckle Dumpster Day event was hosted on October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at Adelante II Elementary school. The special event allowed residents to discard unwanted items/garbage, thus keeping it off our city streets. The Dorsa Miller Dumpster Day event was held on December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022, on Decatur Drive. The special event allowed residents to discard unwanted items/garbage, thus keeping it off our city streets. The Fiesta Navideña event will be held on December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, at Emma Prusch Farm Park. The special event will connect low-income families with various resources so that they can enjoy the holiday season. The Emma Prusch All Inclusive Playground Groundbreaking

event will be held on December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at Emma Prusch Farm Park. The special will break ground on the first all-inclusive playground in East San José and present the vision to the community.

The 11 events were/will be free, open to the public, and sponsored by Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco.

### **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 5, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
