**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE FREE HOLIDAY TREE GIVEAWAY
SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED
SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF
MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the Free Holiday Tree Giveaway event scheduled on December 4, 2022 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the November 29, 2022 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Free Holiday Tree Giveaway event will be held on Sunday, December 4, 2022 at the Roosevelt Community Center and will be sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez and various other community partners. This special event will provide families with the opportunity to register to receive a free holiday tree, participate in family friendly activities and enjoy a day of fun and community. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
