Purpose:	Attend the Program for New Mayors at Harvard Kennedy School of Government from November 30 – December 2, 2022, in Cambridge, Massachusetts. This seminar for newly elected mayors is a dynamic, integrated, non-partisan program for incoming mayors and mayors who have recently taken office from US cities with populations of 75,000 or greater. The program began in 1975 as a collaboration between the Institute of Politics and the United States Conference of Mayors. It gives new mayors access to respected thinkers and practitioners in the public policy arena. In addition, this convening provides mayors a priceless opportunity to build relationships with their colleagues from cities across the country and across the political spectrum, as well as the opportunity to discuss common goals and challenges away from the pressures of city governance.
