## **RECOMMENDATION**

Accept Mayor Liccardo's memorandum to maintain the quality of life in neighborhoods hosting current and future interim housing communities.

## **DISCUSSION**

Thank you to City staff, colleagues, and members of the community who are stewarding efforts to scale solutions to the homelessness crisis in our city. As we collectively approach a key milestone of facilitating 1,000 quick-build interim housing units by year's end, we must strive to incentivize current and future EIH sites by providing host communities with a guarantee that their neighborhoods will be better - not worse - off, for hosting them.

We can only achieve buy-in and support from potential host communities by making specific commitments to residents that their neighborhoods will be cleaner, safer, and free from blight. Providing service enhancements, no-encampment zones, blight reduction, and employment opportunities for the formerly unhoused will create support for these solutions and a stronger incentive for other neighborhoods to embrace them.
