The current Paid Family Leave program is a pilot program negotiated with the unions, which for most will expire June 30, 2023. It is anticipated that
this will be a topic of negotiations next year with these unions. Administration will prepare an info memo that addresses the Councilmember's request
for information as to utilization of the current Paid Family Leave pilot program and the estimated cost of expanding the program from one week of
paid leave to six. However, as changes to this program are subject to the meet and confer process, any discussion about modifying the program
should occur in closed session closer to the expiration of the pilot program and in preparation for negotiations with the unions.
