SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF TOWER AND ROTUNDA LIGHTING FOR SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS PLAYOFFS SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

### RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve a Tower and Rotunda Lighting for the San Francisco 49ers Playoffs scheduled on January 13 January 20, 2023 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups that supported the events.
- 3. Place the item on the January 24th, 2023, Council Agenda for action.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

In lieu of a City Proclamation, the San Francisco 49ers playoffs will be recognized by the City Council on Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. The City Hall Tower and Rotunda will be lit in red and gold to celebrate the success of a Bay Area team that brings joy to many San Jose residents.

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# **ANALYSIS**

City Council Policy 7-14, City Hall Event Lighting Policy, Sections B.1 and C.1 allows Rotunda and Tower lighting in conjunction with proclamations for official actions or ceremonial items as approved by City Council.

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 6, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
