Mayor Liccardo,

Please work to change the city code regarding replacement of council members to prevent future problems such as what we have now--where council members are likely to appoint a representative in-line with personal and political interests rather than someone similar to the one who was elected in the district.

I propose something like this: A council member leaving office during their term can nominate up to three possible successors. The council as a whole can choose to appoint any of the nominees, or hold a special election.

Such a measure would increase the chances of a district having continuing representation that more closely matches the council member they elected. The council as a whole can choose to save money by not holding a special election if they appoint one of the nominees, or they can spend the money on an election.

Additional details could be added, such as if a council member dies in office maybe the chief of staff nominates replacement candidates, or each council member can appoint one or two other members to make nominations for them in the case of their early demise.

Such a measure would address the problem of allegedly high costs of a special election without putting someone in office who does not actually represent their constituents.
