A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, EXECUTE, AND ACCEPT UPON RECEIPT, GRANTS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S NATIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS (I.E. REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY (RAISE) GRANT PROGRAM) UNDER THE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT, (ALSO REFERRED TO AS THE BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW), IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25 MILLION, FOR THE TERMINAL A GROUND TRANSPORTATION ISLAND PROJECT (PROJECT) AT THE SAN JOSE MINETA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (AIRPORT)

WHEREAS, the City of San José ("City") owns and operates the Norman Y. Mineta San José International Airport ("Airport"); and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (also referred to as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and "BIL") provides grant funding for investment in infrastructure modernization; and

WHEREAS, the BIL's Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity ("RAISE Grant Program") helps communities build transportation projects that have significant local or regional impact and improve safety and equity; and

WHEREAS, improved accessibility to public transportation operations and the surface transportation infrastructure, with design and traffic pattern refinement, will improve safety, accessibility, efficiency and functionality at the Airport ("Terminal A Ground Transportation Island Project") and would fit within the criteria for potential BIL RAISE Grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the BIL's RAISE Grant funding will provide reimbursement of 80% of eligible Terminal A Ground Transportation Island Project costs to the Airport;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to apply for, execute, and accept upon receipt, grants from the United States Department of Transportation's National Infrastructure Investments (i.e. Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant Program) under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, (also referred to as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law), in a total amount not to exceed \$25 million, for the Terminal A Ground Transportation Island Project (Project) at the San José Mineta International Airport (Airport).
