

"Grades" based on 2022 PCI Ratings




### **CSJ 2023 Pavement Conditions**






## **Pavement Condition Index (PCI) History**

- Likely to begin declining in 2027-28




## **10-Year Funding Status**



## **Local & Neighborhood Streets**

#### 135 Pavement Maintenance Zones

- Geographically contiguous
- Efficient planning and delivery of paving projects
- Maximize work completed in a neighborhood area
- Provide geographic spread across the City
- Considers Equity Priority Community as a tool in planning phase





## **Local & Neighborhood Streets**

#### 2023 Projects

- 11 minor construction projects (prep)
- 6 major construction projects (1 prep, 1 sealing, 4 resurfacing)
- Addresses approximately 161 miles
- Total funding: \$56.5 million
- Focused on maintenance zones "poor and failed" to maximize cost-effective treatment
- Approximately 649 miles maintained in 2019-2022 (42% of network)





## **Innovation**Reducing Carbon Footprint

- Low-carbon concrete:
  - 40% reduction in carbon footprint
  - Cost-neutral
  - Local material and production
  - American Concrete Institute Award for "Project of the year (photo bottom right)
- About 17,600 ADA ramps to be installed in the next 10 years:
  - 120,000 tons of concrete, or
  - 19,000 metric tons of CO<sub>2e</sub> emissions
- City goals:
  - Implemented low-carbon concrete requirement starting in 2022
  - Long-term goal: reduce <u>7,000 metric tons</u> of CO<sub>2e</sub> emissions in the next 10 years (equivalent to removing 1500 cars from the road in a year)







### Conclusion

#### Investments have yielded results

- Major Streets increase to 78 PCI
- PCI on Local Streets continued to improve from 60 to 67 since 2018.

#### Funding has significantly improved

- Sufficient to properly maintain Major Streets network in "good" condition
- Goal to ensure all Local & Neighborhood Streets will be maintained by 2028
- PCI projected to maintain 70

#### DOT ready to deliver

- 236 miles of street pavement projects in 2023
- Building capacity to plan, procure and deliver in 2023 and beyond
