SUBJECT: ACTIONS RELATED TO THE PURCHASE ORDER WITH SYNLAWN OF CENTRAL CALIFORNIA, INC. FOR SYNTHETIC DOG TURF INSTALLATION AND REPLACEMENT SERVICES

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to:

- 1. Execute a purchase order with SYNLawn of Central California, Inc. (Clovis, CA) for synthetic dog turf installation and replacement services for an initial one-year term, beginning on or about March 29, 2023, and ending on or about March 28, 2024, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,000,000; and
- 2. Exercise up to four one-year options to extend the term of the purchase order with the last option year ending on or about March 28, 2028, subject to the appropriation of funds.

Desired Outcome: Authorizing the City Manager to take this action provides the City with synthetic dog turf installation services.

BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Parks, Recreation, and Neighborhood Services oversees the maintenance of synthetic turf surfaces at various City locations. Synthetic dog turf is used in City parks and other facilities for use by the public. These synthetic turf surfaces are exposed to adverse weather and natural conditions that often leads to damage over time. Synthetic turf installation and replacement services are required for the preservation and safety of City parks and facilities.

In December 2022, a competitive Request for Bids was released by the Finance Department to procure these services. Two responsive bids were submitted and no protests were received. Neither bidder qualified for the City's local or small business preference. Staff recommends award to SYNLawn of Central California, Inc. as the lowest priced, responsive, and responsible bidder pursuant to the bidding procedures of the San José Municipal Code, Section 4.12. 310B. Approval of this recommendation ensures the City receives synthetic dog turf installation and replacement services at various City parks and facilities.

Commission Recommendation/Input: There is no commission recommendation or input associated with this action.
