I am writing to respectfully ask for your support for Councilmembers Candelas and Ortiz's recommendation to maintain the identified 3.2 million dollars in savings from the acquisition of Coyote Valley to address water quality contamination for Lake Cunningham. With San José's steady leadership in environmental justice, it is the responsibility of our city government to ensure that Lake Cunningham Park is put on a pathway toward restoration.

Having represented the City of San José in the State Assembly and previously in the City Council for 15 years, I understand the importance of water quality in our lakes and parks.
