A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE INCREASING THE MONTHLY STIPEND FOR NON-CITY EMPLOYEE MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE FEDERATED CITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT PLAN, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE SALARY SETTING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, in November 2014, voters in the City of San José passed Measure G, amending the powers and duties of the Salary Setting Commission ("Commission") to include making biennial recommendations to the City Council regarding the monthly stipend for non-City employee members of the retirement boards which administer the City of San José retirement plans ("Retirement Boards"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission met on March 29, 2023 and made a recommendation regarding the amount of the stipend which it deems appropriate for non-City employee members of the Retirement Boards; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the recommendation of the Commission.
