#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH SANTA CLARA VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AS PART OF THE US 101/BLOSSOM HILL ROAD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO INCREASE THE TOTAL CONTRIBUTION BY \$225,000 FROM $\$ 55,000$ TO $\$ 280,000$ TO EXPAND THE SCOPE OF SERVICES, WHICH INCLUDE EXTENDING THE VISUAL SCREEN PANELS ON THE BIKE PATH AND UPGRADING THE TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE BLOSSOM HILL ROAD AND MONTEREY ROAD INTERSECTION


WHEREAS, the City of San José ("City") City Council desires to adopt this resolution for the reasons set forth in the memorandum, dated April 17, 2023, from John Ristow, the Director of Transportation, for the May 9, 2023 City Council meeting ("Memorandum"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to negotiate and execute an agreement with Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a Second Amendment to the Cooperative Agreement with Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority as part of the US 101/Blossom Hill Road Interchange Improvement Project to increase the total contribution by $\$ 225,000$ from $\$ 55,000$ to $\$ 280,000$ to expand the scope of services, which include extending the visual screen panels on the bike path and upgrading the traffic signals at the Blossom Hill Road and Monterey Road Intersection.
