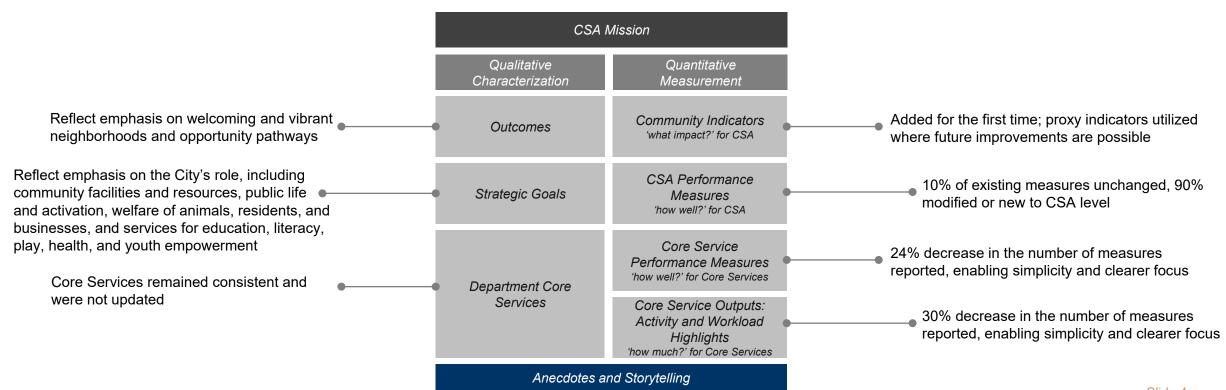

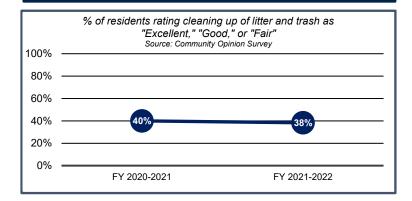

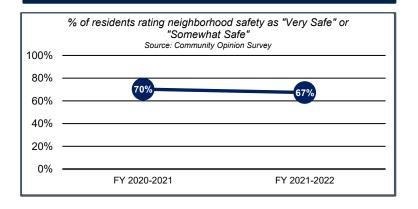

#### **Neighborhood Cleanliness Perception**

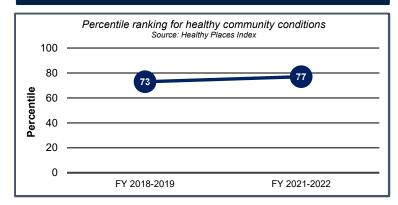

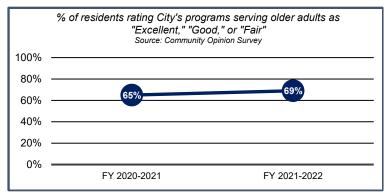

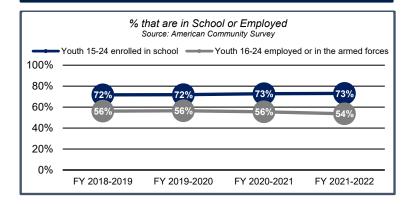


#### City Older Adult Program Rating

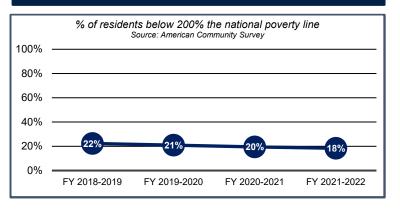

#### **Youth Participation Rates**



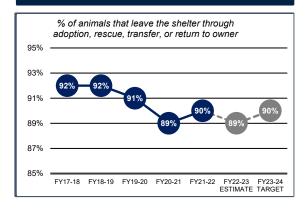
#### **Neighborhood Poverty Rate**



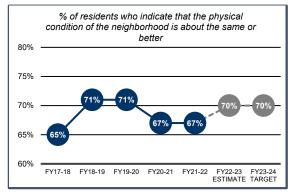

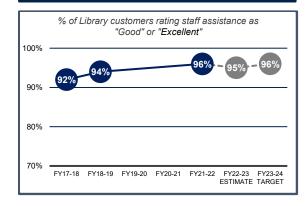
#### **Animal Care Center Live Release Rate**



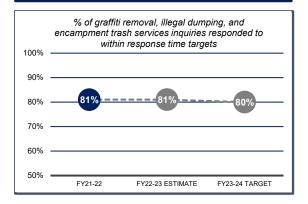
### Code Enforcement Neighborhood Physical Condition Score



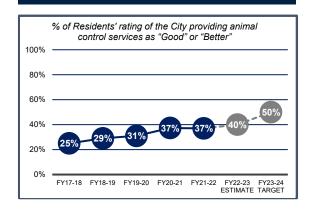

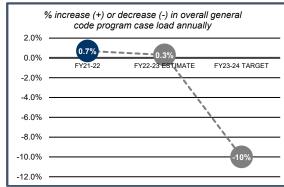
#### PRNS Beautify SJ Response Times



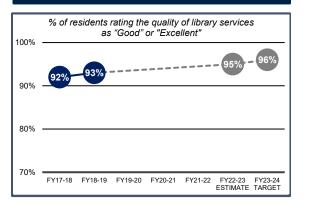
#### **Animal Care Customer Service Rating**



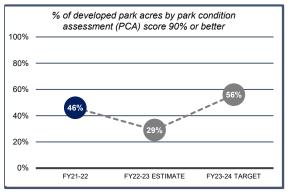
### Change in General Code Program Case Backlog Volume by Fiscal Year
