BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The District 4 Community Leadership Forum was held on Saturday, April 8, 2023 from 8:30 am to 12 pm at the Berryessa Branch Library at 3555 Noble Ave. The purpose of this event was to bring together all the District 4 leaders and commissioners to network with each other and share ideas, as well as have their voices heard on important issues. This event is free and open to the public.

The District 4 Cataldi Park Tree Planting was held on Saturday, April 29, 2023 9am to 12pm at 2900 Cataldi Dr. The purpose of this event was for San Jose Residents to plant, mulch, and water 30 trees as a celebration of Arbor Day.

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This event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember David Cohen will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 4, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
